SPECIALISED PHOTO HIDE EXPERIENCE - SHOMPOLE
SEPTEMBER 16 - 21, 2027

This exclusive photographic safari is designed for experienced wildlife photographers who want to work creatively from **two professionally designed underground photographic hides** in Shompole Conservancy, southern Kenya.

Rather than a standard vehicle-based safari, this experience is built around long, patient hide sessions, including overnight opportunities. The focus is on **low-level wildlife photography, controlled lighting, clean backgrounds, reflections, dust, behaviour, and creative night photography.**

The experience includes time at both **Shompole Plains Hide** and **Shompole Kichaka Hide**. Both hides can be excellent for plains game and regular visitors such as giraffe, zebra, impala, baboons, elephants, hyenas, and other wildlife moving through the conservancy. Both also use controlled lighting systems for creative night photography while keeping the animals undisturbed.

Shompole Plains Hide sits in a more open landscape, making it especially strong for minimalist compositions, reflections, dust, wide scenes, and dramatic encounters with larger wildlife such as elephants, lions, and hyenas.

Shompole Kichaka Hide is positioned nearer to thicker vegetation, but carefully separated from the bush, allowing for clean, uncluttered night-time images. It can be excellent for plains game while also offering exciting possibilities with smaller and more secretive nocturnal species such as caracal, wild cat, and striped hyena.

This experience is **co-led by Mark and Jaren Fernley**, resident photographers of Shompole Hide. Having spent more time inside these hides than any other photographers, they bring a deep understanding of the wildlife behaviour, movement patterns, lighting, and photographic possibilities specific to Shompole.

ITINERARY:

DAY 1: ARRIVAL DAY

Guests arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, Nairobi.

Upon arrival, guests will be transferred to a Nairobi airport hotel, located approximately 10 minutes from the airport.

There will be a meet and greet with your photo host at 6:00pm, where the group will have the opportunity to meet, discuss the upcoming safari, and go through the plan for the following day.

Overnight: Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport Hotel

Important Arrival Note: Guests must arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport **no later than 4:00pm** on arrival day.

DAY 2: FLY TO SHOMPOLE / NIGHT IN PHOTO HIDE

After breakfast, the group will transfer for the private chartered flight to Shompole Conservancy.

Upon arrival, guests will settle in before an evening introduction to the photographic hide. This will include an overview of how the hide works, how the lighting system is used, and how to approach the first night of hide photography.

This evening will be spent overnight in the photographic hide.

Photography Focus: Introduction to Shompole hide photography, low-level wildlife photography, hide etiquette, night photography, and initial photographic opportunities with Shompole's wildlife.

Overnight: Shompole Wilderness Camp / Photographic hide

DAYS 3 - 5: MORNINGS AND EVENINGS IN PHOTO HIDES

Spend three full days working from the Shompole photographic hides.

Each day will typically include an early morning session in the photographic hide, followed by a mid-morning rest and refresh at the lodge. During the day, there will also be opportunities for photo editing, image review, and critique with the photo hosts, depending on the group schedule and guest needs.

Evenings will be spent back in the photographic hides, with overnight sessions designed around wildlife movement, low-light conditions, and creative night photography.

Photography Focus: Morning and evening photographic opportunities may include giraffe, zebra, impala, baboons, birds, elephants, hyenas, lions, and a wide range of other wildlife moving through the conservancy. Night sessions can create opportunities for more dramatic, atmospheric images, including larger nocturnal visitors at Shompole Plains Hide and smaller, more secretive nocturnal species at Shompole Kichaka Hide.

Overnight: Shompole Wilderness Camp / Photographic hide

DAY 6: TRANSFER TO NAIROBI / END OF TOUR

Enjoy one final early morning session in the photographic hide before returning to the lodge to rest and refresh.

The group will then transfer to the airstrip for the private chartered flight back to Nairobi.

END OF TOUR

Important Departure Note: Guests must depart Nairobi **no earlier than 5:00pm** on this day.

PHOTO HIDE ROTATION

During the safari, guests will alternate between Shompole Plains Hide and Shompole Kichaka Hide, ensuring that everyone experiences both photographic hides during the trip.

With four nights in the hides, each guest will spend two nights in Shompole Plains Hide and two nights in Shompole Kichaka Hide. This rotation allows guests to experience the different settings, wildlife movement, lighting possibilities, and night-time photographic opportunities of both hides.

Each hide group will be accompanied by a photo host, with 4 guests + 1 photo host per hide, allowing for a focused and well-supported photographic experience throughout the safari.

- Tubing down the Ewaso Ng'iro River
 - *No additional cost.*
- Bush Walk led by a Local Maasai Guide
 - *No additional cost. Includes the chance to learn about local wildlife tracks, signs, and the surrounding landscape.*
