TOUR:

**GREAT MIGRATION WILDLIFE PHOTO SAFARI - TANZANIA**  
JULY 1 - 8, 2027

This **8-day photographic safari** offers an immersive and highly focused experience in the northern Serengeti during one of the most visually compelling and dynamic phases of the Great Wildebeest Migration.

**Led by professional wildlife photographer Jaren Fernley**, the safari is carefully structured to maximise time in the field, minimise unnecessary travel, and position photographers in one of Africa's most remarkable wildlife environments at the optimal time of year. **The emphasis throughout is on creating meaningful photographic opportunities, allowing guests to observe, anticipate, and capture wildlife behaviour in a thoughtful and deliberate way.**

The journey begins in Arusha before continuing by private chartered flight to Kogatende in the northern Serengeti. From this point onward, the focus is **dedicated to documenting the movement of the migrating herds**, the anticipation and **drama of Mara River crossings**, predator-prey interactions, atmospheric dust-filled scenes, and the constantly changing light that defines this region. Guests will have the opportunity to photograph vast herds of wildebeest and zebra, often numbering in the thousands, as well as **lions, cheetahs, hyenas, and other wildlife that follow the migration.**

Throughout the safari, guests are accommodated in a **luxury mobile tented camp** strategically located in the northern Serengeti, providing close proximity to the migration corridors and the Mara River region. This positioning allows for **early access to key wildlife areas** and the flexibility to respond quickly to unfolding events in the field. With a maximum of three guests per photographic vehicle and a dedicated photo host assigned to each vehicle, the experience ensures both space and flexibility, along with personalised photographic guidance at all times.

**Daily safari outings** are designed around light, wildlife movement, and photographic potential, with the flexibility to remain in the field for extended periods when conditions are favourable. Guests will receive ongoing guidance in composition, exposure, storytelling, and anticipating behaviour, as well as optional sessions focused on image selection and post-processing techniques.

Incorporating **two private charter flights, expert photographic mentorship, adaptable safari scheduling, and a strong emphasis on capturing the Great Migration**, this safari is designed for photographers seeking not only to experience but to thoughtfully document one of Africa's most iconic and visually powerful natural spectacles.

ITINERARY:

**DAY 1: ARRIVAL DAY**

Guests arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO), where they will be met and transferred to their accommodation in Arusha.

In the evening, guests will meet their photographic host for a welcome briefing and introduction to the safari ahead. This session provides time to discuss the itinerary, review photographic goals, and prepare for the days in the field.

*Overnight: Mount Meru Hotel, Arusha*

Guests must arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport **no later than 3:00pm** on arrival day.

**DAY 2: FLY TO NORTHERN SERENGETI / BEGIN SAFARI OUTINGS**

After breakfast, guests transfer to Arusha Airport for the private charter flight to Kogatende in the northern Serengeti.

Upon arrival, the group begins their first photographic safari in the migration region, focusing on locating and monitoring the movement of the herds. Depending on conditions, this may include morning and afternoon photographic outings.

There will also be an introduction to image selection and post-processing techniques, with a focus on photographing the Great Migration.

**Photography Focus:** This will be the group's first day in the field, with the aim of finding and monitoring the migrating herds as they move through the northern Serengeti towards the Mara River.

*Overnight: Esirai Camp, Northern Serengeti*

**DAYS 3 – 7: GREAT MIGRATION PHOTOGRAPHIC SAFARI OUTINGS**

Spend five full days exploring the northern Serengeti and following the movement of the Great Migration.

Each day will be flexible, with either full-day safari outings or morning and afternoon photographic safaris depending on wildlife movement, light, and field conditions. The focus will be on photographing the mega herds of wildebeest and zebra as they move through the region, gather near the Mara River, and potentially cross.

There will also be opportunities to photograph other wildlife throughout the safari outings, including predators and general Serengeti wildlife. Each evening, guests will have the option to take part in image selection, post-processing, and photographic discussion with their photo host.

**Photography Focus:** Each safari outing will be dedicated to finding and monitoring the migrating mega herds of the Great Migration. The group will photograph wildebeest and zebra in their thousands as they move towards the Mara River and, if conditions allow, during dramatic river crossing events.

*Overnight: Esirai Camp, Northern Serengeti*

**DAY 8: DEPARTURE DAY**

After breakfast, guests transfer to Kogatende Airstrip for their private charter flight back to Kilimanjaro International Airport.

The charter flight is scheduled to arrive before 2:00pm.

**End of Tour**

*Guests must depart no earlier than 5:00pm on this day.*
